








Jefferson County Population for Mountain Areas by Census Tracts

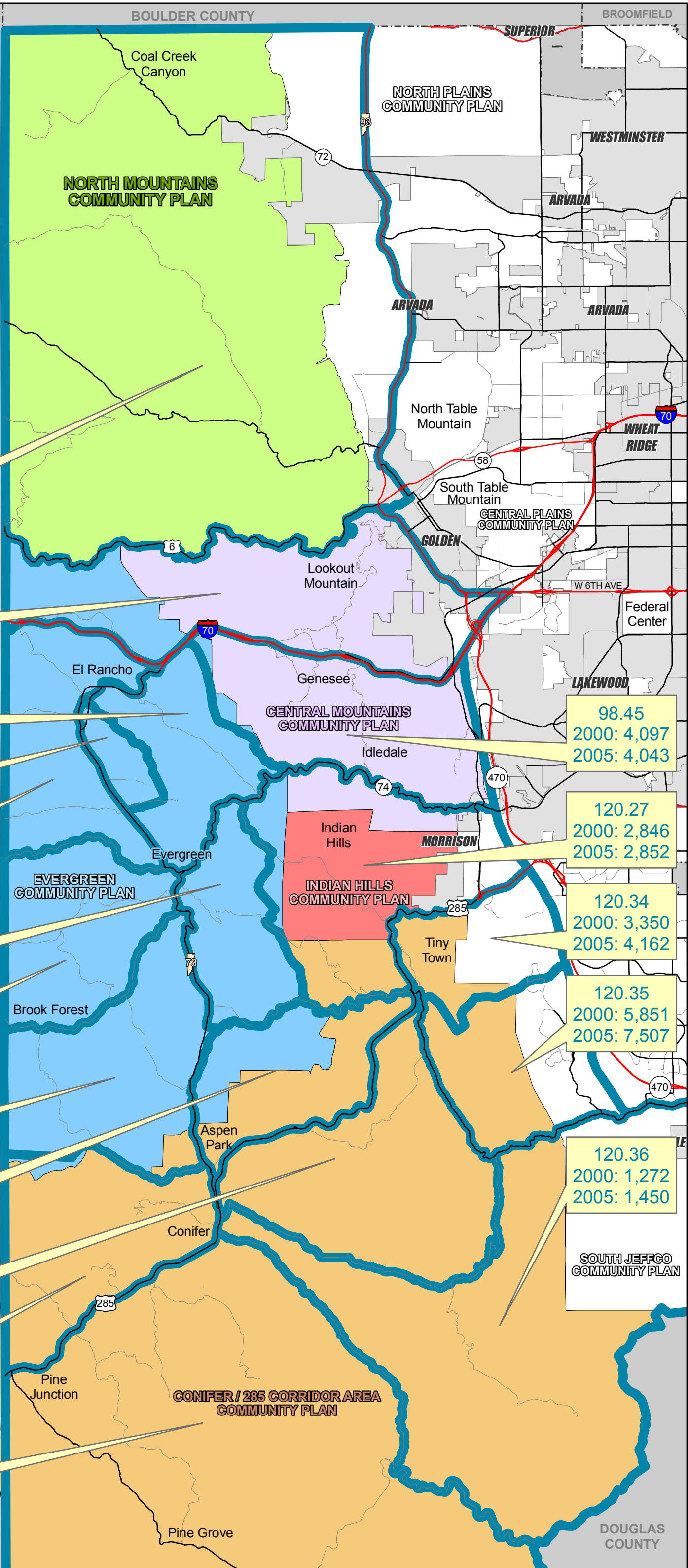
